I'm following up with you on my previous email and the board's request for additional information. Did you receive our answers, and if so, has the board had time to review them? I appreciate your time, thank you.

Thank you for your email and the opportunity to provide the information the Committee requested, I know this is a busy time of year.

Here are the answers to your queries:

- 1. Under the instructors watch the students will start the iv administer the medication, be in control of the monitoring, oversight, airway management, anesthesia record, depending on state requirements, the dr can do dental work at same time.
- 2. NO, our online didactic is 65 hours. Our in person didactic takes place over 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  days, 24 hours, including medical emergencies and Sim-Man day.
- 3. More detailed Syllabus is attached ( agenda from course)
- 4. The drugs taught in our curriculum for a Class II moderate sedation are: DRUGS USED: Midazolam (Versed), Fentanyl, Dexmedetomidine (Precedex), Diphenhydramine (Benadryl), Ondansetron (Zofran), Nitrous Oxide. Zofran is used for nausea.
- 5. Students are chosen for the program with the following criteria: they have a dental license in good standing, they are ACLS certified, they are able to attend the course with their dental assistants.
  6. This is different then other programs, they are seeing ASA 1 and 2 ... types of procedures from operative identity, extraction, and a wide range of clinical needs for these. We try to keep the cases on the shorter side to 90 mins or less.
- 7. Our Sim man is a ten hour IN PERSON day including in our didactic learning that includes :Advanced Airway + Emergencies + Anesthesia Crisis Resource Management Simulation Course
