1	Conditional Approval of the Lauderdale County Solid Waste Management Plan	<b>Order No. 7303 24</b> .	This order conditionally approves a comprehensively updated version of the Lauderdale County Solid Waste Management Plan as proposed by the Lauderdale County Board of Supervisors and the municipalities of Meridian and Marion. The updated version of the plan describes the provisions and services for managing solid wastes in the County for the 20 year planning period as required by State Law. The Order additionally provides the County 120 days to address certain deficiencies pertaining to the proposed inclusion of 4 new/expanding solid waste management facilities.
2	Hinds County	<b>Order No. 7304 24</b> Respondent agreed to submit an interim Storm Water Management Program (SWMP) to MDEQ and comply with this SWMP and the General Permit issued on March 18, 2016 until MDEQ issues a new General Permit.	Respondent was in violation of Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-29(2)(b) for failing to obtain coverage under the Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Storm Water General NPDES Permit that was issued on March 18, 2016.
